SUBJECT : ENDORSEMENT LETTER FROM HON. ROMMEL ANTHONY V. MAGBITANG FOR THE PASSAGE OF A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE LOCAL CHIEF EXECUTIVE TO ENTER INTO DEED OF DONATION AND ACCEPTANCE WITH DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE, REGIONAL FIELD OFFICE IV-A, FOR THE MARKETING EQUIPMENTS EXCLUSIVELY FOR USE IN THE IMPLEMENTATION OF KADIWA NG PANGULO PROGRAM IN THE MUNICIPALITY

A meeting of the **Committee on Agriculture and Natural Resources** was held last March 12, 2026, attended by Vice Chairperson **Arnel G. Milay** and **Engr. Elma Valenzuela** of MABE, to discuss the **Deed of Donation and Acceptance** with the Department of Agriculture – **Regional Field Office IV-A**, for marketing equipment exclusively for use in the implementation of the Kadiwa ng Pangulo Program in the Municipality of Naic.

The donation includes **five (5) foldable tables** valued at ₱24,150 and **one (1) weighing scale** valued at ₱3,850, intended for use in the Kadiwa ng Pangulo Program. Under the agreement, the equipment must be properly used, maintained, and the recipient shall shoulder any repair or maintenance costs.

It was proposed to remove certain provisions in **Letter D**, which restricts the sale or mortgage of the equipment without the donor’s consent, as these are similar to **Letter E**, which allows the donor to revoke the donation in cases of misuse. It was also suggested to correct the barangay name in the document from **Brgy. Poblacion** to **Brgy. Ibayo Silangan, Naic, Cavite** for accuracy.

Engr. Valenzuela explained that the equipment will be under the care of MABE but will be accounted for by the **General Services Office (GSO)** and used exclusively during the Kadiwa ng Pangulo Program. These donations are additional to previously rented equipment, which is often leased for the program. The Municipality of Naic is considered fortunate to receive this equipment, as it actively participates in the program, allowing more residents to benefit. The program is held at the Naic Covered Plaza during the last month of each quarter, except the 3rd quarter (August) and 4th quarter (November). The equipment may also be used for other Department of Agriculture programs if necessary.

Before an activity can be called a Kadiwa ng Pangulo event, it must be properly coordinated and included in the official schedule of the **Agribusiness and Marketing Assistance Division (AMAD)**. The program has three main components:

1. Fresh agricultural products, including rice, vegetables, fruits, and fish;
2. Processed goods, both food and non-food;
3. Mercado stalls or ready-to-eat food for micro-enterprises.

Typically, only **twenty (20) participants** are accommodated in Naic due to the limited space at the Naic Covered Plaza. A price survey is conducted beforehand to ensure that the prices



of products are not higher than those in the local market; prices may be lower but not higher. Participants are not limited to residents of Naic, as the program involves coordination with the national government. Support, such as trucks and other equipment, is provided, and beneficiaries are expected to participate in related programs even if held in other locations. Not all municipalities in Cavite implement the Kadiwa ng Pangulo Program, making Naic one of the few fortunate to be included.

The **Kadiwa ng Pangulo Program** is a government initiative that assists farmers in selling their produce, facilitates regional exchange of local products such as OTOP, and provides market opportunities for micro, small, and medium enterprises, while ensuring affordable products for the public.

Finally, the body agreed to submit a resolution authorizing the **Local Chief Executive** to enter into the **Deed of Donation and Acceptance** for the receipt of marketing equipment exclusively for use in the implementation of the Kadiwa ng Pangulo Program.
