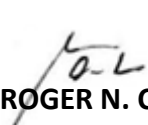
SUBJECT : **PROPOSED ORDINANCE 2026-014 - AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE USE OF
VIDEOKE, KARAOKE, AND OTHER AUDIO-AMPLIFIED MACHINES IN THE
MUNICIPALITY OF NAIC, CAVITE**

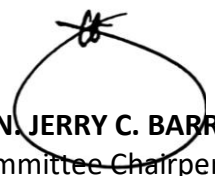
A committee hearing was conducted in coordination with the Naic Municipal Police Station (MPS) and the Liga ng mga Barangay Board of Directors to discuss the proposed ordinance regulating the use of videoke, karaoke, and other audio-amplified devices. These have become common forms of entertainment among residents of the Municipality of Naic, Cavite, particularly during gatherings and celebrations; however, their unregulated and excessive use, especially during late hours, has resulted in increasing complaints due to noise disturbances affecting nearby residents.

In line with Article II, Section 15 and Article II, Section 5 of the 1987 Philippine Constitution, this measure seeks to protect public health and maintain peace and order by regulating the use of such devices.

As agreed upon by the Joint Committee, violations shall be penalized through a graduated system: P/500.00 for the first offense, P/1,000.00 for the second offense, and P/2,500.00 plus confiscation of equipment for the third and subsequent offenses. Exemptions are granted to barangay festival celebrations, which may extend until 12:00 midnight, and to duly authorized establishments with adequate soundproofing, which may operate on a 24-hour basis, provided that sound levels remain reasonable and do not cause undue disturbance to the community.

In view thereof, the Committee recommends the approval of Proposed Ordinance No. 2026-014, entitled "An Ordinance Regulating the Use of Videoke, Karaoke, and Other Audio-Amplified Machines in the Municipality of Naic, Cavite," pursuant to the Safer Cities Initiative of the Department of the Interior and Local Government.
