SUBJECT : **PROPOSED ORDINANCE 2026-015 - AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 10, SERIES OF 2017, AND ENACTING A NEW CURFEW ORDINANCE FOR MINORS IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF NAIC, CAVITE, AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS THEREOF**

A committee hearing was conducted in coordination with the Naic Municipal Police Station (MPS) and the Liga ng mga Barangay Board of Directors to review and deliberate on the necessity of strengthening existing curfew regulations for minors within the Municipality of Naic, Cavite. It was noted that under Section 16 of the Local Government Code of 1991, local government units are mandated to promote the general welfare, which includes the maintenance of peace and order and the protection of life and property. The proposed measure is likewise aligned with the objectives of the Safer Cities Initiative, which aims to ensure safer communities by minimizing the exposure of minors to risks during late-night hours.

During the deliberation, it was emphasized that the proposed curfew seeks to safeguard minors from potential harm such as crime, accidents, and other unsafe situations commonly occurring during nighttime. The ordinance establishes curfew hours from 10:00 PM to 4:00 AM and provides specific exemptions for minors under legitimate circumstances, including those accompanied by parents or guardians, attending school or religious activities, responding to emergencies, engaged in authorized employment, or traveling with adults.

The Committee also reviewed the proposed penalty provisions under Section 6 of the ordinance, which impose progressive sanctions on minors found violating the curfew. For the first offense, the violator shall be required to render four (4) days of community service, with two (2) hours per day. For the second offense, the penalty shall be a fine of One Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (₱1,500.00) in addition to four (4) days of community service, with two (2) hours per day. For the third and succeeding offenses, the penalty shall be a fine of Two Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (₱2,500.00) and four (4) days of community service, with two (2) hours per day. These graduated penalties are intended to promote discipline, parental responsibility, and compliance with the curfew regulations while ensuring the welfare and protection of minors.

The Committee hereby recommends the approval of the proposed ordinance, as it is deemed necessary, reasonable, and consistent with the mandate to promote the general welfare, maintain peace and order, and ensure the safety and protection of minors within the Municipality of Naic, Cavite.
