SUBJECT: PROPOSED ORDINANCE 2026-014 - “AN ORDINANCE REGULATING
 THE USE OF VIDEOKE, KARAOKE, AND OTHER AUDIO-AMPLIFIED
 MACHINES IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF NAIC, CAVITE”

The joint committee meeting was called to order at exactly 1:59 PM by the Committee Chairperson, Hon. Roger N. Camilo. The MLGOO Ms. Christine B. Sierra, Plt. Renz Rumbaoa & Plt. Angelene Hernandez representative from Naic Municipal Police Station (MPS), Liga Board of Directors and Councilor Glennon I. Pegollo was present and actively participated in the meeting. The Committee Chairperson, Hon. Roger N. Camilo, opened the deliberation on the proposed ordinance pursuant to the mandate of the Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG) under Memorandum Circular No. 2026-029, entitled “Encouraging the Enactment of Local Ordinances for Safer Cities: A Call to Action for Local Government Units.”

The proposed ordinance No. 2026-014 entitled: “An Ordinance Regulating the Use of Videoke, Karaoke, and Other Audio-Amplified Machines in the Municipality of Naic, Cavite,” was presented and read before the body. It was explained that videoke, karaoke, and other audio-amplified devices have become common forms of entertainment among residents, especially during gatherings and celebrations. However, their unregulated and excessive use, particularly during late hours, has resulted in increasing complaints due to noise disturbances affecting nearby residents.



In line with Article II, Section 15 and Article II, Section 5 of the 1987 Philippine Constitution, the proposed measure aims to protect public health and promote peace and order through proper regulation of such devices.

After thorough deliberation, the Joint Committee agreed on the following provisions:

- **A graduated penalty system shall be imposed for violations:**
 - First Offense: ₱500.00
 - Second Offense: ₱1,000.00
 - Third and Subsequent Offenses: ₱2,500.00 plus confiscation of equipment
- **Exemptions shall be granted to:**
 - Barangay festival celebrations, which may extend until 12:00 midnight
 - Duly authorized establishments with adequate soundproofing, which may operate on a 24-hour basis, provided that sound levels remain reasonable and do not cause undue disturbance to the community

In view thereof, the committee unanimously recommends the approval of Proposed Ordinance No. 2026-014, entitled: "An Ordinance Regulating the Use of Videoke, Karaoke, and Other Audio-Amplified Machines in the Municipality of Naic, Cavite," in support of the Safer Cities Initiative of the Department of the Interior and Local Government (DILG).

There being no other matters to discuss, the meeting was adjourned at 2:21 PM.
